THE ORIGINATION OF THE PROJECT

The major problem for VVU SRC since its birthing has been the lack of a befitting office for its leadership and the leadership of the various schools and faculties that constitute it. In an attempt tackle this challenge, the leadership of the Council of the student body during the 2016/2017 academic year, proposed a 2-storey office complex with shops and a mini conference hall called "SRC MULTIPURPOSE CEN-TER". A fund was subsequently set up for that purpose.

The 2019/2020 leadership of the SRC handed over the "Building Plan" and "a graded land" to the current administration on the 7th August, 2020. Picture 1 shows the state of project site at the time the current administration took office.

WHAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED SO FAR

The implementation of actual works commenced on August 10, 2020 on the site after preliminary consultations with the Works and Physical Development Department and the selection of a contractor for the project were completed.

DESCRIPTION OF THE BUILDING

The SRC Building Complex is intended to have 15 offices, a conference hall, and four spaces for shops. The shops and the conference hall will be located on the ground floor. The first floor is designated as offices for the leadership of the associations of the various Schools/Faculties and the Alumni. The 2nd floor has been designated for SRC Executives. The estimated total cost of the building is **GHC1**, **410**,**668**.00. The amount spent on the project so far is **GHC339**, **000.00**. This amount has been wholly funded by the SRC.

The project is divided into two Phases:

Phase I:

This phase comprise the foundation works, flooring works, block works, and roofing.

Phase II:

Phase two comprise plastering, fixing of doors and windows, tiling, electrical and plumbing works, and painting.

OUR TARGET

Our target for raising funds for the project is to complete the first phase and some parts of the second phase of the project.

The works left to complete the first phase are the flooring works, block works for 1^{st} and 2^{nd} floor, and roofing.

THE AMOUNT NEEDED TO COMPLETE PHASE I & A SECTION OF PHASE II

An estimated amount of **GHC600**, **000.00** would be needed complete Phase I and some sections of Phase II. This is intended to make at least 30% of the building complex habitable (**GHC 365,730.00** would be needed to complete phase I and **GHC 234,270.00** to complete about 30% of Phase II). The SRC intends to raise the remainder of the estimated total costs of the project through membership dues over the next few semesters
