### Entry Requirements

#### 1. RM / SRM / RGN & Post Basic NAC & NAP Applicants

- Applicants with Diploma in Registered Midwifery (RM) will start the Bsc Midwifery from level 300
- Applicants with Certificate in State Registered Midwifery (SRM) will start from level 200
- Applicants with Registered General Nursing (RGN) will start from level 200
- Applicants with Post Basic Midwifery (HAC / NAP) will start from level 200 after an 8-week Access course

#### Other Requirements (for RGN / SRM / RM & Post Basic HAC/NAP)

- Applicant must be a registered Nurse or Midwife from an accredited institution
- Applicant must have a valid Professional Identification Number (PIN) or Auxiliary Identification Number (AIN) issued by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC)
- Applicant must have completed at least 2 years of nursing / midwifery practice

#### 2. WASSCE Applicants

Applicants holding West African Secondary School Examination Certificate (WASSCE) with grades of A1 - C6 in three (3) Core subjects; English, Mathematics and Integrated Science and in three (3) Elective Subjects in following programme options; Science, General Arts, or Home Economics may also apply.
