## Under-graduate entry requirements

1. SSSCE/WASSCE holders:  
Credit passes (A-D/A1-C6) in six subjects comprising three (3) core subjects, including English Language, Mathematics, Integrated Science/ Social Studies, plus three (3) relevant elective subjects.
2. GBCE holders: Credit passes (A-D) in six subjects comprising three (3) core subjects, including English Language, Mathematics, Integrated Science / Social Studies, plus three (3) relevant subjects.
3. Diploma in Basic Education/3-year Post Secondary Teacher's Cert 'A' holders are eligible to apply for degree programmes in Education.
4. GCE Advanced Level: Passes in three (3) subjects (at least, one of the passes should be Grade D or better). Also, the applicant must have had credit passes (Grade 6) in five GCE Ordinary Level subjects including English Language, Mathematics and a Science subject (for non-Science students) and an Arts subject (for Science students).

5. Baccalaureate (from French-speaking countries), and other Foreign High School Diploma equivalent to WASSCE. Such certificates should be evaluated by the National Accreditation Board.
6. Registered General Nursing/State Registered Nursing Certificate/Diploma holders.
7. Mature Students: Applicants must be 25 years and above, and should pass the University's Mature Entrance Examination comprising English Language, Mathematics, and General Paper.

Valley View University started as Adventist Missionary College at Bekwai, Ashanti in 1979 by the West African Union Mission of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. In 1983, the College was relocated to Adenta, and finally to its present site at Oyibi on the Accra-Dodowa Road in the Greater Accra Region in 1989. In 1997 Valley View University became the first private university to be accredited by the National Accreditation Board of Ghana. The University, in 2006, received a Presidential Charter to be the premier private University in Ghana to award her own degrees, diplomas, and certificates.
